## WORLD CUP 2010 PRESENTATION

### 1. Background information of *Cheetah Experience*

*Cheetah Experience* was started in 2006, by Riana van Nieuwenhuizen, as a non-profit organization. Our mission statement is to promote and fund the conservation of the Cheetah and other endangered species through captive breeding, behavioural research and public awareness.

As mentioned, we are a non-profit organization (NPO 058 424) that relies only on donations and monies raised through hosting tours. We have no official sponsors as yet. *Cheetah Experience* has a few permanent inhabitants and we also raise various cat species for other game farms and private owners. The

animals leave us when they are of an appropriate age. (When they are less dependent on their care-givers.)

Some of the permanent animals to be seen at *Cheetah Experience* include cheetah cubs and adult cheetahs, lions, wolves, caracals and a serval. Other animals can also be seen depending on availability (if there are cubs being looked after at that specific time) and their age.



## 2. General information on tours

We provide tours every day to the public.

On Wednesdays and Saturdays at 10:00 there are special tours for children under the age of 12 only. Special other tour times can also be arranged.

A tour includes seeing various animals in enclosures from a very close range, learning interesting facts about the animals you are visiting and touching some of the animals as well. Guests are allowed to take photos as well as video recordings as long as it remains for private use only.

We can accommodate groups of up to 60 people at a time (special arrangements need to be made for large groups like this) or very small groups or individuals. Our rates are R250 per person for adults and R125 per child aged younger than 12 (all children pay). There is an indemnity form that the guests have to sign prior to going on a tour.

If possible please book in advance for any tour. If guests have not made a booking, they can arrive at reception about 20 minutes prior to a tour. (We would appreciate a booking for larger groups to be made in advance.)

### 3. Special tours

We also provide game drives where guests can see 32 species of game in the wild from an open-air vehicle. Space is limited to 10 persons at a time. The cost hereof is R300 for adults and R175 for children under the age of 12. This kind of tour must please be booked in advance.

### 4. Facilities

There are bathrooms available for the guests who are on tour at *Cheetah Experience*. There is also a wonderful curio shop, *Spoilt Cat*, which sells beverages, water, snacks, postcards and other memorabilia from your experience with us. The tour consists of short walks to the enclosures. Some of the enclosures and animals can be reached in a wheelchair. There is also a cash bar available for guests who are waiting for a tour to begin. Unfortunately no refreshments may be taken into any enclosure.

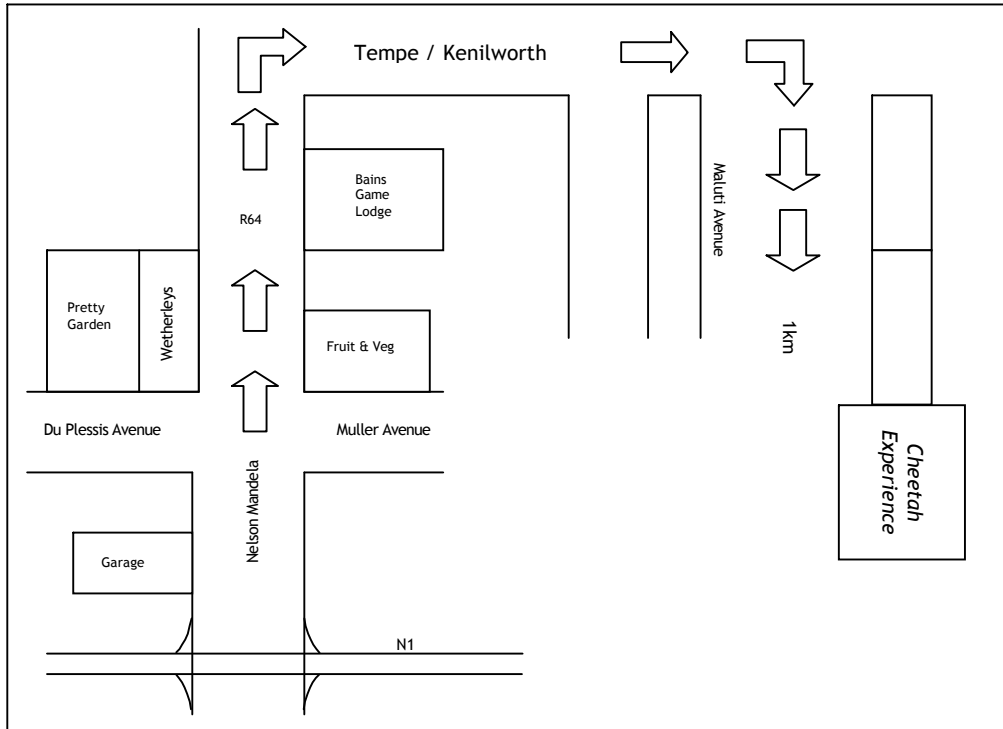
### 5. Shuttle services / transport arrangements

We will be able to shuttle guests to and from *Cheetah Experience* by arrangement. The cost hereof will be R80 per trip per person one way. (To and from *Cheetah Experience* will be R160 per person)

*Cheetah Experience* is accessible by bus. The bus will stop outside the gate and there is then a short walk for the guests to reception. We also provide safe parking inside the grounds for cars at no extra cost.
